Care Guide

Clean: to physically remove dirt, marks, or unwanted matter, especially by washing, wiping, or brushing.

Disinfect: to cleanse with the intent to destroy, inactivate, or significantly reduce the concentration of pathogenic agents such as bacteria, viruses, and fungi : to treat with a chemical-based disinfectant.

- For dust, gently vacuum Oomph. Smooth attachments recommended; do not use stiff brush attachments that might damage the weave or loosen fibers. Alternately, a clean dampened cloth can be used to remove dust with a patting motion.
- **To disinfect,** use any household disinfecting spray (e.g. Fantastik[®]) following the manufacturer's instructions.
- **Remove spills immediately** using damp, clean cloth. Dab Oomph with a clean, soft white cloth dampened with a *mild* solution of liquid detergent and warm water. Repeat process using clean water, then pat dry with a lint-free cloth.
- For more difficult stains, dampen a soft white cloth with a solution of household bleach (10% bleach / 90% water). Dab gently. Repeat using only a clean, water-dampened cloth to remove bleach concentration then pat dry with a lint-free cloth.
- Avoid using abrasives, solvents or wax polishes.
- Always test cleaning products/methods in an inconspicuous area first. If care instructions don't deliver the expected results, cease cleaning method immediately and contact Takeform for assistance.
